How to Participate in the Leaf Collection

Place gathered leaves in biodegradable, paper bags (No Plastic Bags) **or** gather loose leaves in heaping piles. Leaves must be at the curbs by 7:00 AM for pick-up.

Kindly wait until after trash collection on Thursdays to place bagged leaves at the curbs.

First-Class Neighborly Practices

Snow and Ice Removal

Please keep the sidewalks or walkways clear of snow and ice to prevent accidents. Often, neighbors cannot maintain their properties because of health issues: *please lend a helping hand to those in need.*

Building Numbers

The Property Maintenance Code mandates that all buildings in Harmony Township have proper numerals for addresses. Install block-style numbers at least four (4) inches in height placed in a position plainly legible and visible from the front streets to ensure emergency personnel can identify properties.

Dog Owners

Please be mindful of the neighbors especially late at night with barking dogs.

Garbage Day – Thursday

Kindly take refuse cans out within ten (10) hours prior to trash pick-up. Retrieve empty refuse cans within ten (10) hours after trash pick-up. Please stow trash cans on the sides or backsides of houses.

Outdoor Storage

The following items are prohibited from outdoor storage: unlicensed and uninspected vehicles, refrigerators, stoves, washers, laundry tubs, televisions, mechanical/ electrical equipment, large tools, and building/construction materials.

Drop-Off Site for Holiday Trees and Wreaths

Live trees and wreaths during the holiday season fill homes with the smell of fresh pine as well as showcase some of the most cherished ornaments collected over the years along with twinkling lights. However, the holiday season lasts only a short time.

After the holidays, reduce the number of trees or wreaths placed outside for trash pick-up because they can be recycled and reused as mulch.

To recycle **non-artificial** holiday trees or wreaths, visit the Do-It-Yourself Recycling Site located at 2801 Woodland Road, Ambridge, PA 15003. Place trees or wreaths containing **no** ornaments **or** stringed lights on the side of the dark green, Yard Waste Box.
