The good news is that the Township has tentative approval for the NRCS Grant in the amount of \$300,000.00. This Grant was procured by the Township Manager and the Board of Commissioners and HRG.

No political help was given in procuring this Grant. Tentative start date is October 1st. The Township is also looking at a USDA Loan is 3.275% over 30 years which will cover the second half of the expenses for repairing Woodland Road Landslide. The goal for this repair is to have the project finished before winter. The Board of Commissioners is in the process of compiling a report for just Roads in Harmony Township that are prone to Landslides. With the help of HRG Engineers Harmony Township is applying for the LSA Grant which awards a million dollars. The repair of Ridge Road alone will be in the millions.
